1.	Adv. Manisha Kulkarni read the minutes of last meeting. Dr. Abhay Kulkarni welcomed everyone and ensured that everyone is good at health.
	Dr. Jyoti informed about the progress of Teaching and Learning of MBA department and added that virtual SPPU- Summer Internship Program (SIP) was successfully completed from 21 May to 24 May, 2021.  The SEM IV teaching and learning started from 15 <sup>th</sup> Feb, 2021 and even completed the syllabus and their SPPU exams will be started from 11 <sup>th</sup> August to 2 <sup>nd</sup> September, 2021. SEM IV started earlier for maintaining the quality and students engagement. The SEM II started from 7 <sup>th</sup> June, 2021 and will complete till 31 <sup>st</sup> August, 2021.  Revision sessions were conducted and industry expert sessions for all the courses provided added value after completion of each unit. All evaluations through CCEs of SEM IV are completed and for SEM II are in process.  Ms. Renu Mathew from MCA informed that MCA II lectures resumed after a break for Sem III university examination from June 7 <sup>th</sup> and MCA III resumed from June 6 <sup>th</sup> . Lectures are conducted through MS Teams as per the scheduled Time table. Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation is in process through the ERP. MCA I Sem II lectures have started from June 15 <sup>th</sup> with an orientation session on Course Outcomes. As per SPPU directives the semester end will be August 31 <sup>st</sup> or maximum September 4 <sup>th</sup> . Remedial classes will be followed by the term end examination planned in September.  MCA III Sem VI external viva- voce is planned in mid-August. We have finalized the internal marks for the same and is waiting for the SPPU portal link

to be open for marks entry.

 Adv.Manisha informed the students are engaged in evaluations with different types like Group Discussions, Role play, Thematic presentations, In depth vivavoce, Case study with online tools.

Series of session on Specialization Inclination were conducted to enlighten the students for choosing the right specialization matching their strength.

Mr. Sanjay Mathapati from MCA department shared the details of the expert sessions organized in the month of July. A session on NodeJS and API calls was conducted on July 10th 2021 by Mr. Sambhav Choradia, Software Engineer-Backend, Solute Labs were JavaScript frameworks, NodeJS installation and npm was elaborated. He also covered NodeJS scaffolding, calling external APIs, use of Postman tool and database connectivity through Node.

A session by IICMR alumni, Mr. Ishwar Bathe, Software Developer, Cybage Software Pvt. was conducted on July 10th 2021. The session mainly aimed to provide insights on Angular, Front end web framework.

The Entrepreneurship focus group students attended a session on Entrepreneurship: A Journey of Learning by Mr. Sunil Deo, India Head, RackWare Inc. The speaker shared his views on the importance of entrepreneurship with ample illustrations and discussion. He enlightened students with grass-root knowledge about the ways to start up.

A hands-on session on Hadoop Installation was organized on July 26th 2021 by the resource person, Mr. Prakash, Andhale, Hadoop Administrator, Citius Tech Healthcare Tech. Pvt. Ltd. The session included introduction to Amazon Web Services followed by AWS account creation and guidance on EC2 instance in the AWS platform. The remote computing tool MobaXterm installation was taught to students to connect the windows machine with the EC2 virtual machine.

Dr. Abhay Kulkarni Suggested to complete the portion till 31st August, 2021





and then will allow students for preparation leave. Mr. Maruti shared the MBA placements updates as received from Placement head that MBA Placements drives conducted for premium companies like Bislery, NJ India, Saint Gobain, Persistent, Interactive Brokers, Visible Alfa Deustch Bank etc. so far 70 companies participated in campus drives and 30 students are successfully placed in national and multinational companies. Placement updates of MCA 2022 passing out batch Mrs. Renu Mathew shared that the placement drives for MCA 2019-22 and 2020-22 batches are going on. We have conducted placement drives for Cummins India Pvt. Ltd., Magneto IT Solutions Pvt. Ltd., ValueBound Consulting Services LLP, Blue Flame Labs, PolyScript Technologies and vCreaTek Consulting Service Pvt. Ltd. Members of IQAC praised the efforts of the both the department for their continuous efforts in conducting Curricular, Co-Curricular and Extra Curricular activities in spite of pandemic situation. 1.	Dr. Manisha read the minutes of the last meeting and Dr. Abhay Kulkarni welcomed all members and appreciated Dr. Manisha for her successful completion of her doctoral degree. He said that this is the proud moment for the institute. All the IQAC members congratulated her for the wonderful defense viva . Dr.Manisha express her gratitude to all IQAC members and especially to Dr.Abhay who is also her guide and to Dr.Ashwini, Dr.Deepali and PGRC center for their continuous support and motivation in the entire journey of research.  Dr. Jayasri informed about the proud moment for institute is that Dr. Abhay Kulkarni was elected on committee 2021–2023 of the institution of engineers (India) Pune Local Centre from Electrical Engg Division. and promoting to participate in ICC activities and initiate Institute of Engineers PC chapter.
2.	Dr.Deepa informed that this year under PGRC, Three research scholars Dr.Manisha, Dr. Krishnan and Dr. Bharati has successfully defended the PhD viva and have been awarded with Doctorate of Philosophy under Organizational and Computer Management respectively.

MCA III Sem V syllabus will be completed by Mid-December and Semester End examination, Practical examination and Project Viva will be completed by
	24th December, 2021. Dr.Jayasri added that MBA II year students have started SIP from 20th October, 2021 and MBA 1 students session will start after the completion of admission procedure
