Dr. Abhay Kulkarni was felicitated by the PCMC authorities for his exemplary work for performing social responsibility.



Overall it was a learning experience



# 5. Activity Experience:



- 2. To be able to depart some happiness in the lives of the patients.


## 5. Activity Experience:
